How to enter

1a. Yachts and smacks.

1. Handicapped Race, there are two courses this year. designed to ensure that all boats have the possibility of finishing within the time limit and to reduce the need to shorten course. Both start at West Mersea and finishing at Osea Island. Classes 1 - 9

First start 0800.

2. Parade of Sail, Osea Island to Maldon - First boat in each class wins (smacks and bawleys sail as one class). Gaffrigged yachts sail in two classes (under and over 24ft OA).

Start approx 1200.

Complete the entry form and sign the declaration. Return with £ 10 entry fee, (cheques made payable to **Maldon Town Regatta Association**) to;

Last minute entry by phone to 07884268053, then complete an entry form and sign the declaration, pass to the 00D on the Committee boat in good time before the race. Sailing instructions will be handed to you.

Please Note: all communication throughout the race will be conducted on VHF Ch.77

2a. Dinghies - Race from Maldon Yacht Club.

2b. Dinghies - Race from Blackwater Sailing Club.

AJI cadets under 18 years eligible. Complete full details of your entry and sign the declaration. There is no entry fee, then contact Mary Wild at the Blackwater Sailing Club 01621 853923.

3. Motor Cruisers.

There will be two Events this year a Predicted Log - given a set course and speed you will need to say how long the course will take you and a

Motorboat Parade - best dressed motorboat into Maldon.
